Let's come together, celebrate fully, and keep moving forward, together.

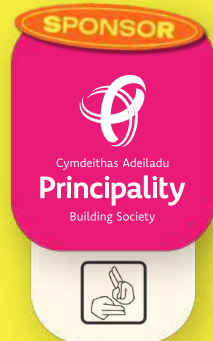

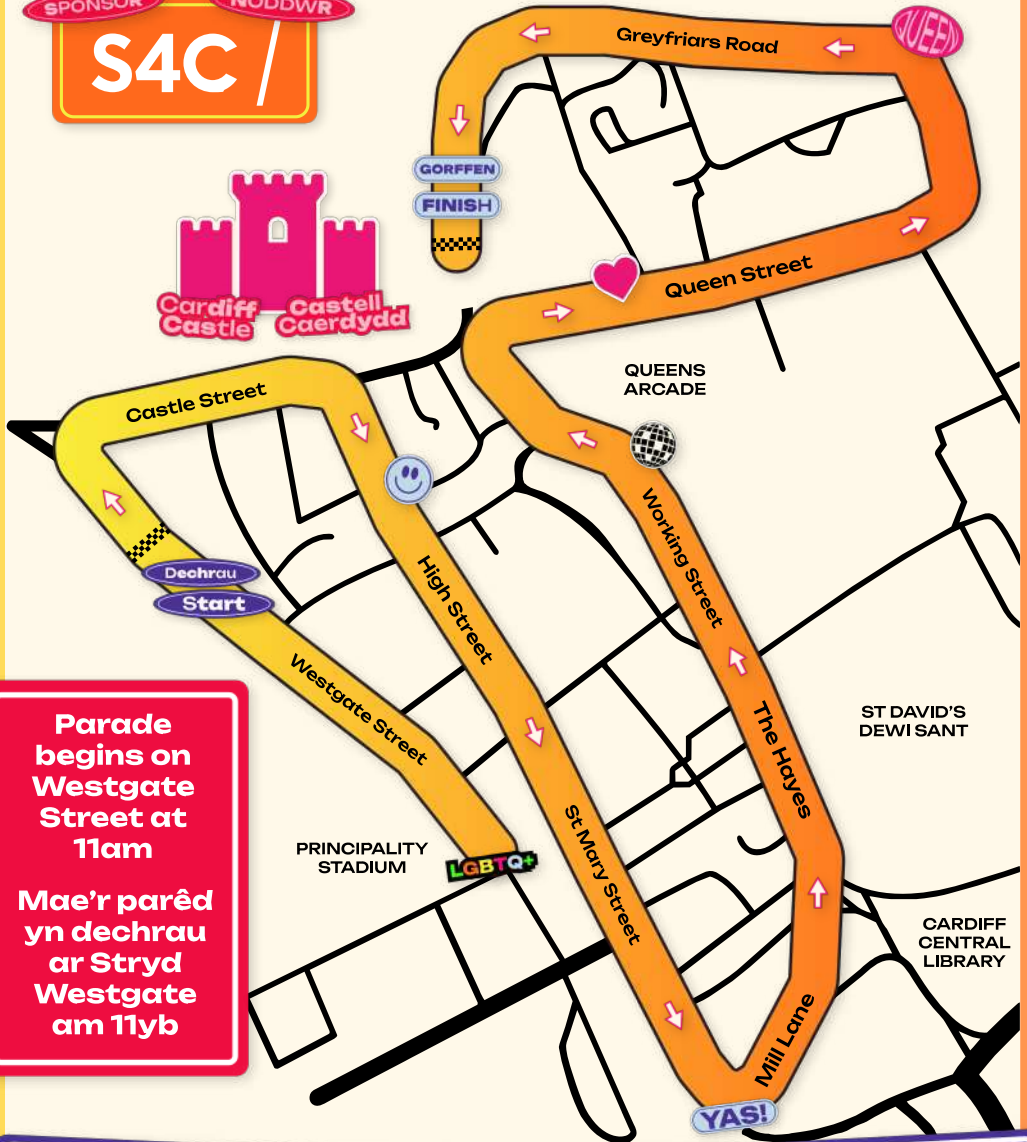

# Markets

# FAMILY AREA

We're The OverTheres - a playful bunch of professional puppeteers, storytellers and neurodivergent creatives from South Wales who believe stories should be fun, engaging, interactive and inclusive. Using puppets, theatre, workshops and imagination, we pop up in libraries, festivals, schools and community spaces to help children explore books and creativity beyond screens.

From roaming puppet adventures to cosy story sessions on blankets with a good book, our work is all about making children feel welcome, included and excited to join in. We love celebrating creativity, identity and self-expression, and we're delighted to be bringing some OverThere magic to Pride Cymru's family area this summer!

And then what we plan to do at Pride:

At Pride Cymru 2026, The OverTheres will be bringing playful pop-up puppetry, interactive storytelling and cosy story sessions to the family area across the weekend. On Saturday, our puppet characters will roam the space sharing short improvised adventures, meeting families, posing for photos and encouraging children to join in with storytelling and imaginative play.

On Sunday, we'll slow things down with a comfy storytelling corner full of books, cushions, blankets and interactive read-alongs. Families will be invited to listen, act out stories alongside our puppet characters, explore characters and celebrate creativity, kindness and self-expression together in a relaxed and welcoming environment.

# ACCESSIBILITY

We recognise that some members of our community may need extra support to fully enjoy the festival, and we're committed to making Pride Cymru as accessible as possible for everyone.

Our dedicated Access Team will be onsite throughout the weekend, and contactable prior to the event, to offer assistance and ensure you can enjoy Pride safely and comfortably.

Accessibility tickets are available for deaf, disabled and neurodivergent people that may require extra provisions in place to enjoy the event.



# ACCESSIBILITY

We offer an access wristband system to people that purchase an accessible ticket, which allows unquestioned access to provisions including but not limited to:



A viewing platform with seating



Re-entry to the site as needed



Accessible toilets, including a fully equipped Accessoloo unit with an electric hoist, grab handles, and adjustable changing table.



BSL interpreters for performances on the Principality Building Society Main Stage, Cabaret Stage, and Community Stage.



Designated Quiet Area with seating and a selection of fidgets, noise cancelling headphones and activities for if you need to decompress or get away from the hustle

## Medical

The Medical Tent at Pride Cymru is a crucial part of ensuring a safe and enjoyable experience for all attendees. Staffed with medical professionals, the tent provides immediate assistance for any health concerns, from minor injuries to more serious conditions. Located near the Accessible Viewing Platform, the Medical Tent is equipped to handle emergencies and offers a reassuring presence, so everyone can celebrate with peace of mind knowing that help is readily available if needed.

## Welfare

Located next to the Medical Tent, Platform will be on hand for wellbeing advice and support. Whether you're feeling in distress, have over indulged or simply want a place to chill out away from the crowds, our Welfare Tent is a safe haven for festival attendees, advising on issues including drug and alcohol abuse, safe sex, addiction, exhaustion & domestic issues.



# Practical Information

## Water

Water points are located at each toilet block for you to fill your reusable bottles or cups and free drinking water is available across all the festival bars.

## Lost Kids

Should you lose them, or they lose you, our welfare team is on hand and based at the Welfare Tent. Report your lost child to any volunteer or security immediately and follow their advice.

## Safety

Pride Cymru is a safe space for our community to celebrate diversity and equality, and we expect attendees of all of our events to embrace and respect this. Pride work with our event delivery partners during all stages of our planning, ensuring that the event is a safe experience for all. Violent, threatening, or offensive behaviour of any kind will not be tolerated whether it's against staff, volunteers, parade participants, market stall holders, security personnel or members of the public.
