What is the Parade?



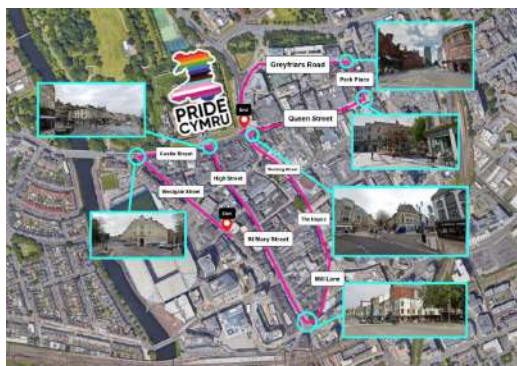
The Pride Cymru Parade is a march celebrating those in the **LGBTQ+** Community.

LGBTQ+

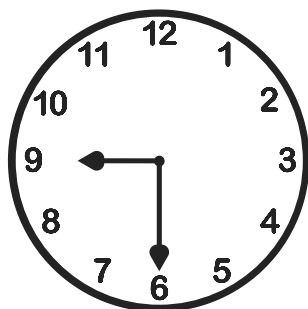
LGBTQ+ stands for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer or questioning. The plus is to be inclusive to everyone that feels part of the LGBTQ+ community but don't feel like they fit into the groups listed in LGBTQ.



The Parade takes place on Saturday 13th June, 2026.



The parade will roughly be 2.5 kilometres in length.



If you are walking in the parade, arrive on Westgate Street at 9.30am to get ready.

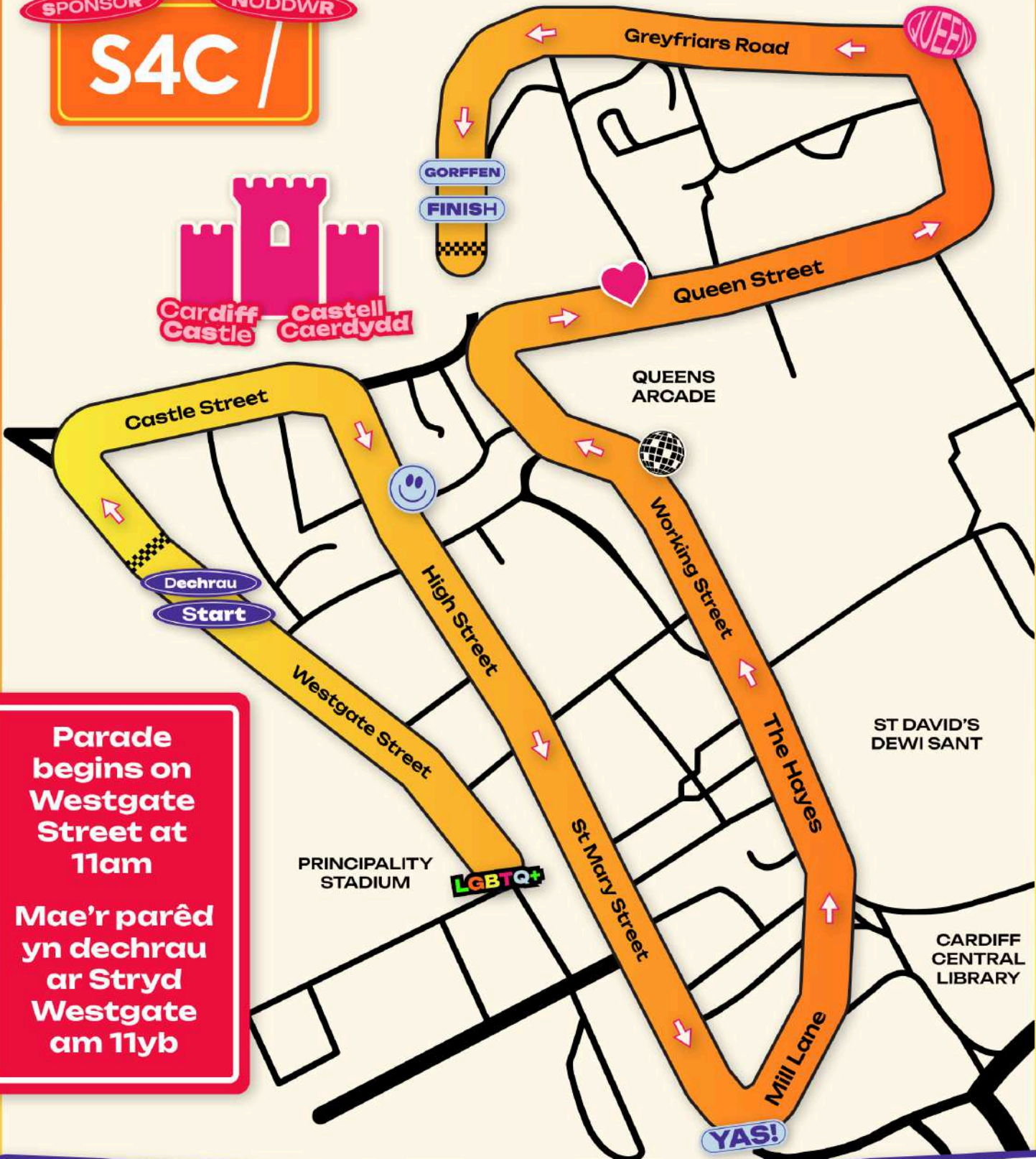

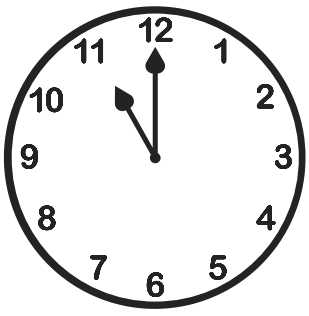

The parade starts at 11am and will roughly take 2 hours and 30 minutes.

What to expect



The Pride Cymru Parade will have many people taking part.



The Pride Cymru Parade is for everyone. People of all ages, genders, sexualities and abilities will be taking part. Many different organisations will take part in the parade.



Large groups of people will gather along the parade route. It will be extremely busy, whether walking in the parade or watching it.



There will be balloons, streamers, flags, fans and bubble machines used during the parade.

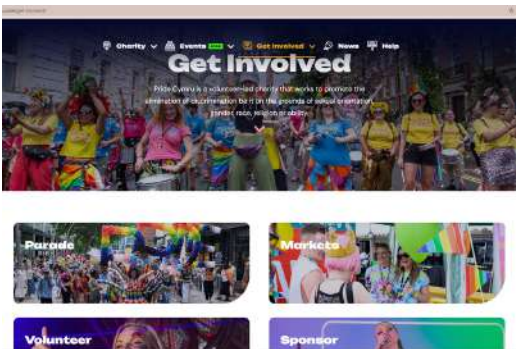


Loud noises will be made including cheering, shouting, stamping, instruments and loud speakers.



Volunteers will be available to help guide people during the parade.

There is an access area in the 'White' section of the Parade.

A quieter area in the parade will be at the back in the 'Green' section.

You are welcome to use these areas or your assigned section if you would prefer.



A BSL interpreter and access volunteers will be in the access area to support you in the parade.



Parade route



The Parade sets off from Westgate Street.



At the top of Westgate Street turn right onto Castle Street.



The Parade will move south towards High Street.



Opposite the Castle Entrance, turn right onto High Street.



The Parade will continue straight onto St Mary's Street



At the bottom of St Marys Street, the parade will make a sharp left onto Mill Lane.



The parade will move north up to the library and continue straight onto The Hayes.



The Parade will continue straight onto St Mary's Street



The Parade will keep right from The Hayes and through Working Street and St John Street





At the top of St John Street by the Castle, turn right onto Queen Street.



When the parade is at the carousel, turn left onto Park Place.



The parade will turn left again onto Greyfriars Road.



The parade will proceed along Greyfriars Road and move towards Kingsway/the Cardiff Castle wall.



Once at Kingsway, the parade will disperse.
Please follow the directions from Pride Cymru volunteers.
