
With thanks to our Parade Partner, Hodge Bank, their support pays for road closures, traffic management and stewarding to keep you safe.

MARKETS



PRACTICAL INFORMATION

MEDICAL

The Medical Tent at Pride Cymru is a crucial part of ensuring a safe and enjoyable experience for all attendees. Staffed with medical professionals, the tent provides immediate assistance for any health concerns, from minor injuries to more serious conditions. Located near the Accessible Viewing Platform, the Medical Tent is equipped to handle emergencies and offers a reassuring presence, so everyone can celebrate with peace of mind knowing that help is readily available if needed.

WELFARE

Located next to the Medical Tent, Platiform will be on hand for wellbeing advice and support. Whether you're feeling in distress, have over indulged or simply want a place to chill out away from the crowds, our Welfare Tent is a safe haven for festival attendees, advising on issues including drug and alcohol abuse, safe sex, addiction, exhaustion & domestic issues.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

WATER



Water points are located at each toilet block for you to fill your reusable bottles or cups and free drinking water is available across all the festival bars.

LOST KIDS

Should you lose them, or they lose you, our welfare team is on hand and based at the Welfare Tent. Report your lost child to any volunteer or security immediately and follow their advice.

SAFETY

Pride Cymru is a safe space for our community to celebrate diversity and equality, and we expect attendees of all of our events to embrace and respect this. Pride work with our event delivery partners during all stages of our planning, ensuring that the event is a safe experience for all. Violent, threatening, or offensive behaviour of any kind will not be tolerated whether it's against staff, volunteers, parade participants, market stall holders, security personnel or members of the public.
